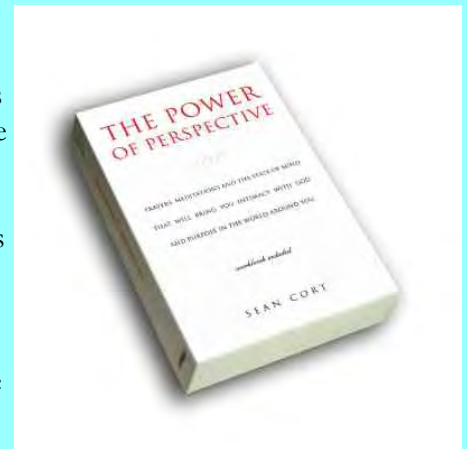

We need to rely on the expert to get us there safely. In the case of the aircraft we need the auto-pilot; in the case of life we need the Comforter that Jesus left us, The Holy Spirit. As you stand at the beginning of this next chapter in life and another New Year, ask yourself; "how much of the former self that got me here needs to be simply put to rest?"
